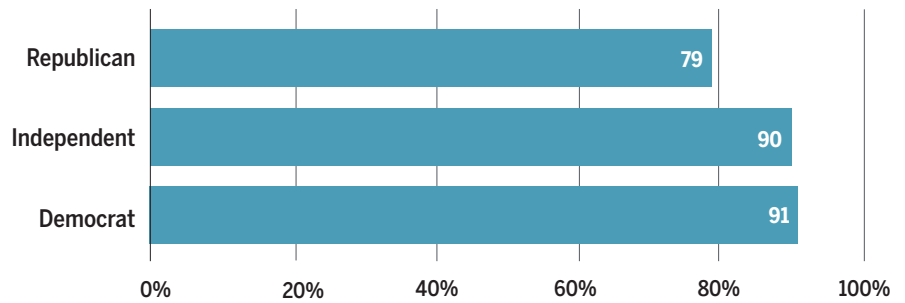


# Make Pell Work: Voters Support JOBS Act

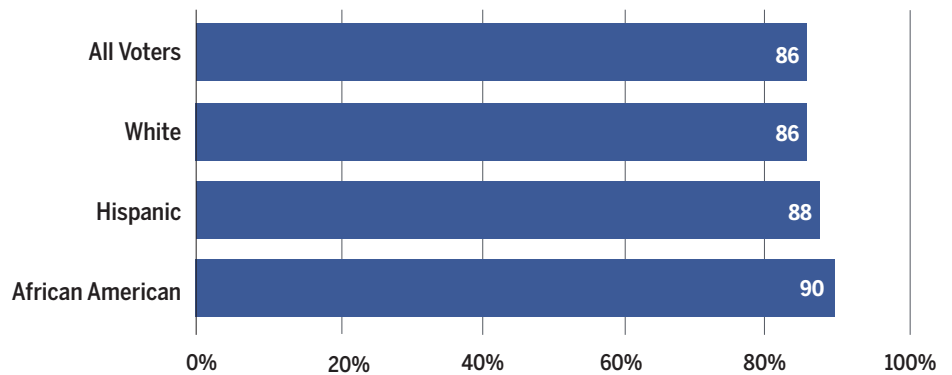
Our current federal financial aid system is biased against working people seeking short-term training to improve their lives, and the businesses that want to hire them. The JOBS Act would remove this bias and expand Pell grants to short-term certificates, not just degrees. Overwhelmingly, America's voters support the goal of the JOBS Act. A national poll of likely 2020 voters found overwhelming support for making federal financial aid available for job training.

## 86 percent of voters support making federal financial aid available for skills training.

**Support is strong across party lines.**



**Support is particularly high with African American and Hispanic voters (90 percent and 88 percent respectively).**



**Support is strong across regions, particularly in the South and Midwest.**
