MARK YOUR CALENDAR

Stay ahead of what's happening in workforce policy – and know exactly when your advocacy can have the biggest impact. This calendar highlights major milestones, funding cycles, and opportunities to engage with NSC campaigns throughout 2026. Use it to **plan your outreach** to policymakers and partners, **stay ready** for key federal and state advocacy moments, and **coordinate your message** with NSC's national efforts. Together, we can keep workforce issues on the agenda all year long:

JANUARY 2026	FEBRUARY 2026 - FY27 BUDGET PROCESS	MARCH - MAY 2026
Start of 119th Congress, Second Session – Map out your advocacy goals for the year. Gather the data, stories, and evidence you'll need to make a strong case to policymakers.	Presidential Budget Development – A critical moment to advocate for strong workforce funding. Flag programs at risk and urge your members of Congress to protect and strengthen key investments.	Appropriations Discussions and Community Project Submissions – Connect with your members of Congress as they shape FY27 funding. Call on them to protect investments in people and employers, and support community project requests that strengthen your local workforce.
EXPECTED JUNE 2026	JULY 2026	
House/Senate Appropriation Markup for Labor HHS Funding – Monitor spending proposals closely. Identify any cuts or policy changes that may affect programs, partnerships, or local workforce ecosystems – and share impacts with NSC's networks and policymakers.	Congressional Recess – Home Visits – Schedule site visits for members of Congress and host local events. Bring members of Congress to the ground so they can learn how good workforce policy choices can help people access skills training, meet their basic needs, and find pathways to good jobs. Program Year Starts for Workforce Pell Grants – Report back to Department of Education on the implementation process and elevate any challenges.	
OCTOBER 2026	NOVEMBER 2026	
Election Year Recess – Prepare educational materials for future leaders. Share how workforce policies support workers, businesses, and local economies.	Midterm and Special Elections – Educate, inform, and bring awareness of workforce wins and challenges with future leaders.
